



"Making Waves" Quilt Show Categories

OCTOBER 21-22, 2011 AT PRAIRIELAND PARK

(Quilt entries open to Saskatchewan residents only)

1. **Large Quilts - Hand Quilted:** Greater than 240 inch perimeter.
 2. **Large Quilts - Self Machine Quilted:** Greater than 240 inch perimeter.
 3. **Large Quilts - Professionally Machine Quilted:** Greater than 240 inch perimeter.
 4. **Medium Quilts - Hand Quilted:** 80 - 240 inch perimeter.
 5. **Medium Quilts - Self Machine Quilted:** 80 - 240 inch perimeter.
 6. **Medium Quilts - Professionally Machine Quilted:** 80 - 240 inch perimeter.
- NOTE: ENTRIES IN CATEGORIES 7 and 8 MUST NOT BE THE PRODUCT OF A KIT OR PATTERN.
7. **Innovative Quilts - Landscapes:** Maximum 240 inch perimeter.
 8. **Innovative Quilts - Contemporary:** Maximum 240 inch perimeter.
 9. **New Generation Quilters:** Entries from quilters who are 16 years old or younger.
 10. **Small Quilts:** Maximum 80 inch perimeter.
 11. **Group Quilts:** Completed by 2 or more people (any size).
 12. **Seasonal Quilts:** Specially made for holidays like Christmas, Chanukah, Halloween, etc. (any size).
 13. **Wearables:** Clothing can be 2 or 3 layers.
 14. **Specialty Techniques:** Quilts that contain machine embroidery, hand embroidery, punch needle, rug hooking, wool appliqué, needle felting, yo-yo quilting, and photo transfer.
 15. **Recycled Quilts:** Quilts made from recycled fabrics, clothing, ties, drapery etc.
 16. **Miscellaneous Items:** Bags, dolls, table runners, placemats, cushions, fabric bowls, boxes, etc.
 17. **Making Waves Theme Challenge:** Presented by Unique Textiles. Fabric kits containing 3 fat quarters available from Unique Textiles for a cost of \$13.00.
Rules: a) Represent show theme Making Waves; b) may make a wallhanging no larger than perimeter of 100 inches, wearable or purse; c) must be embellished (thread discounted at Unique Textiles)
 18. **Puzzle Category - "Where in the World Am I Waving From?":** Open only to members of the Saskatoon Quilters' Guild. This category was presented at the December 2010 potluck. If you require information, please contact Sandy Allen.
