

MYSTERY QUILT FEBRUARY 8th

Subunit 6: Only one needed.

Cut one - 4" x 4" square from background fabric
- 4" x 4" square from fabric 2.

Make one half square triangle from these two squares sewn $\frac{1}{4}$ " on each side of the diagonal, right sides together. Cut on the diagonal line. Press open and trim to 3.5" square. You will have one HST left over.

UNIT 3 - We will make FOUR of these Friendship star blocks, using fabric 1 as the star, and the background fabric as the block background. Instructions are given for ONE block.

Cut - four 2.5" x 2.5" squares from the background fabric
- one 2.5" square from fabric 1
- two 3" squares from the background fabric
- two 3" squares from fabric 1

Using the 3" squares of background fabric and fabric 1, make four half square triangles, by sewing $\frac{1}{4}$ " on each side of the diagonal, right sides together. Cut on the diagonal line. Press open and trim to 2.5" square.

Assemble the above pieces to form a friendship block. Press flat. It should measure 6.5" x 6.5" square.

Repeat the steps above to make a total of four identical friendship blocks.

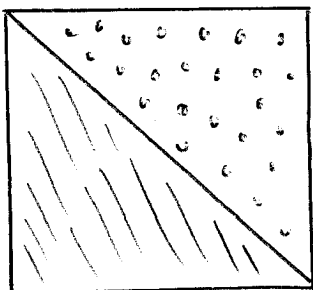
UNIT 4 . We will make one friendship star block, using fabric 1 as the star, and fabric 2 as the background of the block.

Cut - four 2.5" x 2.5" squares of fabric 2
- one 2.5" square from fabric 1
- two 3" squares from fabric 2
- two 3" squares from fabric 1

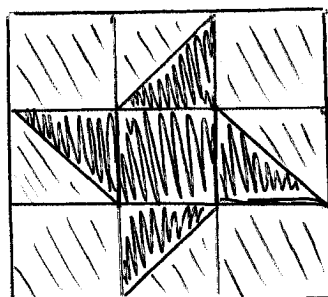
Using the 3" squares of fabrics 1 and 2, make four half square triangles by sewing $\frac{1}{4}$ " on each side of the diagonal right sides together. Cut on the diagonal line. Press open and trim to 2.5" square.

Assemble the above pieces to form a friendship star block. Press flat. It should measure 6.5" square.

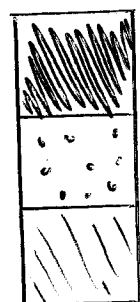
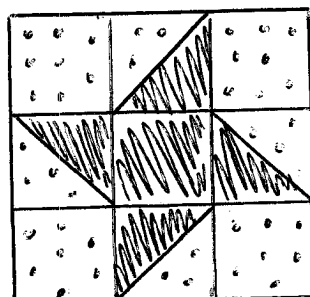
