**Fabric requirements were not included in the first set of instructions but are as follows:**

**.8 of a meter for background**

**.5 of both Fabric 1 and 2**

**if you want a border you will need 5 strips of fabric and we used 4 1/2 inch w.o.f. strips**

**5 - 2 1/2 inch w.o.f. strips for binding**

**Start the quilt with Unit's 1 & 2**

**You will need your Background fabric and your Fabric 2.**

**Unit 1 (4 required)**

**Cut 2 - 7 by 7 squares from both the Background fabric and the Star 2 fabric. Using a pen or pencil draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of each Fabric 2. With right sides together, place one Background and one Fabric 2 together. Using the diagonal line on the Fabric 2, sew a scant 1/4 inch seam on either side of the diagonal line (\*\*\*) a scant 1/4 inch is a thread short of being a full 1/4 inch.)**

**Repeat with second Background and Fabric 2 squares. Press sewn units flat. Cut along the diagonal line on each set, press open, and square up each piece to 6.5 by 6.5 inches. You now have 4 half square triangles (hst). Label these pieces as unit I and put safely aside.**

**Unit 2**

**This is simple. Cut 4 6.5 by 6.5 squares from both the Background and the Fabric 2. Label as unit 2 and put safely aside with unit 1.**

**\*\*\* Save your strips and use as economically as possible.**
