

Mystery Quilt Instructions Nov. 23/09 Sub-units 1&2

Sub-unit 1 (You will need 3 and instructions are for total number needed).

Cut 12- - 1.5 by 1.5 inch squares from Background fabric

Cut 3- - 1.5 by 1.5 inch squares from Star 1 fabric.

Cut 6- - 2.5 by 2.5 inch squares from Background fabric.

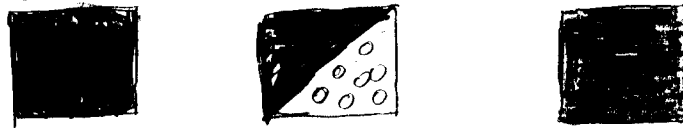
Cut 6- - 2.5 by 2.5 inch squares from Star 1 fabric.

Set aside the 12 1.5 inch square Background pieces and the 3 1.5 inch square Star 1 fabric pieces.

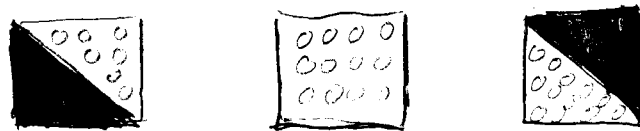
Using the 2.5 inch squares, draw diagonal lines on the wrong side of the star 1 fabric. Using the Background and the Star 1 fabric, make half square triangle just as we did for unit 1 sewing on either side of the diagonal line with a scant $\frac{1}{4}$ inch seam. Press flat, cut on diagonal line and trim to measure 1.5 by 1.5. You will end up with 12.

Lay out as follows:

Top row: 1 Background square + 1 diagonal + 1 Background



Center row: 1 diagonal + Star 1 square + 1 diagonal



Bottom row: 1 Background + 1 diagonal + 1 Background



Join rows together and press flat. It should measure 3.5 by 3.5. Repeat with remaining squares. Label all 3 small star units as sub-unit 1 and put safely aside.
