

**Sub-unit 2 (you will need 3 and total for all 3 are given)**

**Cut 12---1.5 by 1.5 inch squares from Star 2 fabric**

**Cut 3--- 1.5 by 1.5 inch squares from Star 1 fabric**

**Cut 6--- 2.5 by 2.5 inch squares from Star 2 fabric**

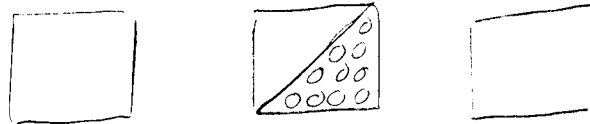
**Cut 6--- 2.5 by 2.5 inch squares form Star 1 fabric**

**Set aside all 1.5 inch squares of both Star 1 and Star 2 fabric.**

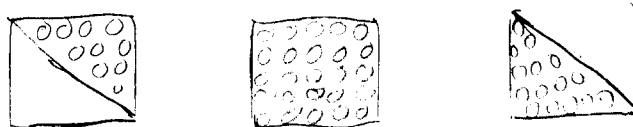
**Using the 2.5 inch squares draw a diagonal line on the lightest of the Star fabrics. Using the same method as we did for unit 1 join the two squares together on either side of the diagonal using a scant  $\frac{1}{4}$  inch seam. Press flat, cut along the diagonal and square up to 1.5 by 1.5.**

**Layout as follows:**

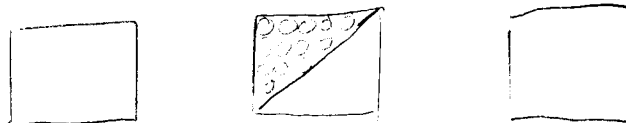
**Top row; Star 2 square + diagonal + Star 2 square**



**Center row: diagonal + Star 1 square + diagonal**



**Bottom row: Star 2 square + diagonal + Star 2 square**



**Join rows, press and trim to 3.5 by 3.5. Label as sub-unit 2 and put safely aside.**
