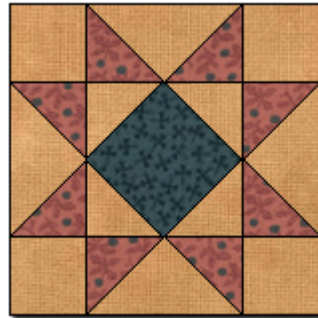


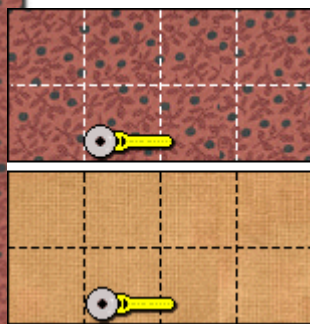

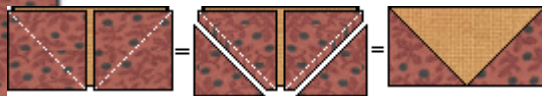
** Preparing the Pieces and Sewing the Block **



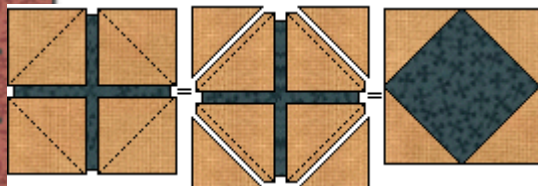
Cut the Color 1 and Color 3 7" x 14" strips into eight 3-1/2" squares of each...



Then cut the Color 3 3-1/2" x 26" strip into four 3-1/2" x 6-1/2" rectangles...



To make a side unit, place a Color 1 square right sides together atop a Color 3 rectangle, with outer edges aligned. On the back of the top square lightly mark the diagonal. Sew on this diagonal marking. Cut off the excess seam allowance. Press the remainder towards the corner. Repeat this with another Color 1 square on the other end of the rectangle. Make four of these...



In the same manner as in the step above, sew Color 3 squares to the four corners of the Color 2 6-1/2" square to make the block's center unit...

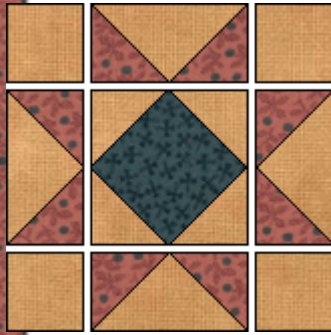

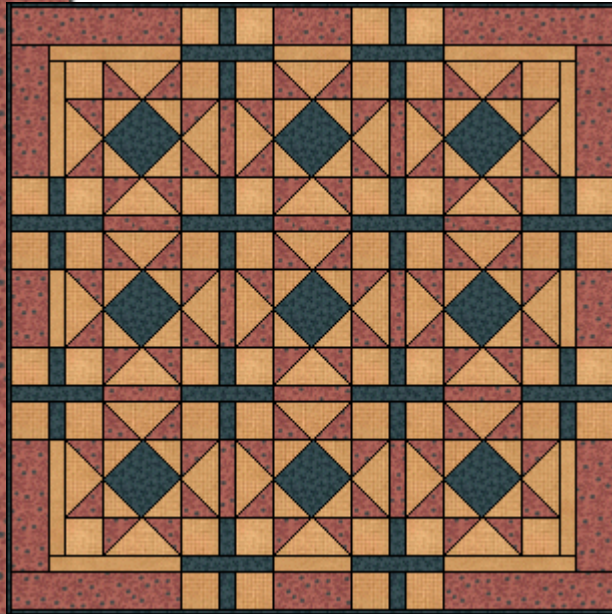

Lay out all units as shown at left. Sew three horizontal rows, pressing the top and bottom row seams to the outside, and the middle row seam to the center. Sew the rows together that's all there is to this one!
