

Option 2: Sew blocks with sashings/cornerstones, add simple border

Beginner Skill level

Quilt Size 34.5" x 48"

Cutting the Borders, Sashings and Cornerstones:

Medium Fabric (sashings)

Collect your 0.4m piece of medium fabric

Cut 6 strips, 2" x WOF

Subcut the strips into (17) 2 x 12½" rectangles.

Dark Fabric (cornerstones)

Cut from leftover border strips

Cut (12) 2" squares

Dark Fabric (Borders)

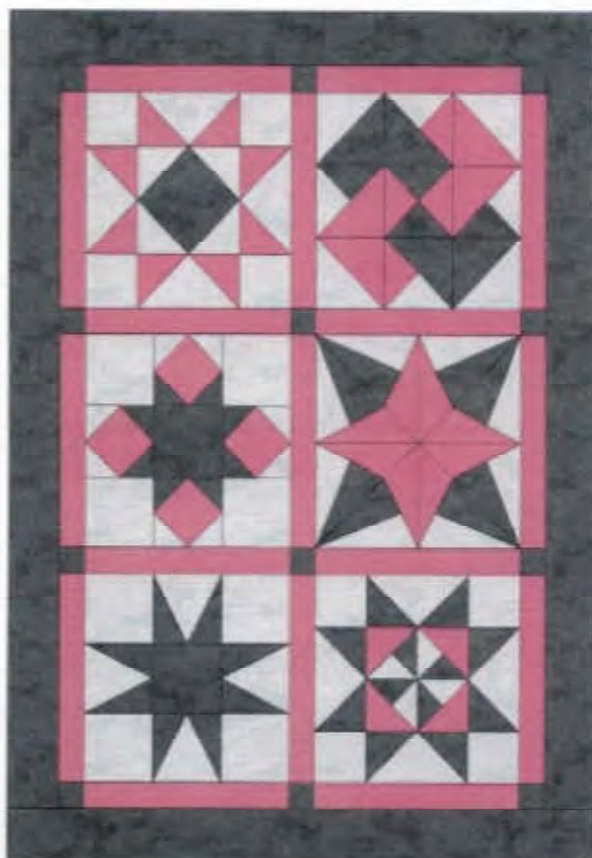
Collect your 0.5m of dark fabric

Cut (5) 3 ½" x WOF strips

Subcut (2) 3 ½" x 35" top/bottom borders

Subcut (2) 3 ½" x 42½" strips, **either** by sewing three strips together and cutting so that the seams are not near the corners, **or** by taking the remainder of the top/bottom borders and sewing them to a WOF strip.

Use the leftovers to cut the cornerstones.



Sewing quilt centre:

Lay your blocks out in your preferred arrangement, placing sashing strips and cornerstones as shown. Sew together in rows. The sashing rows will consist of a cornerstone, a sashing, a cornerstone, a sashing, and a cornerstone.

Sew all of your rows together to make your centre "panel".

This panel should measure 29 x 42½"

Add borders:

Add the side borders (3½" x 42½" strips) first. Press carefully.

Add the top/bottom borders (3½" x 35" strips). Press carefully.

Your quilt top is complete. It should measure 35" x 48½"

Quilt and bind as desired. **Binding needed:** 5 strips x your preferred width
